

DIVISION O - FIELD CROPS

Any entry of grain shall consist of one quart in a clear glass container.

Class

- 994 - Barley - 1 qt.
- 995 - Oats - 1 qt.
- 996 - Rye - 1 qt.
- 997 - Wheat - 1 qt.
- 998 - Soybeans (black) - 1 qt.
- 999 - Soybeans (yellow) - 1 qt.
- 1000 - Corn (shelled) - 1 qt.
- 1001 - Corn (ten ears)
- 1002 - Corn (longest ear)
- 1003 - Indian Corn (10 ears)
- 1004 - Sunflower
- 1015 - Corn (best single ear)
- 1016 - Corn, best appearance (3 stalks cut off at ground level - no roots)
- 1017 - Hay, one flake, at least 80% alfalfa, tied and in clear plastic bag 10

HONEY

All honey and beeswax must have been produced by the exhibitor within a 15-month period prior to entry. All honey exhibited must have been gathered and ripened in a natural way by honeybees. All extracted honey entries must be exhibited in 1 lb. glass jars. All chunk and finely granulated honey entries must be exhibited in jars of one pound or more capacity. All section comb honey entries must be wrapped in clear cellophane.

Class

- 1056 - Dark extracted honey - 1 lb. jar
- 1057 - Light extracted honey - 1 lb. jar
- 1058 - Section comb honey - light (2 sections)
- 1059 - Section comb honey - dark (2 sections)

DIVISION Q – CHILDCARE

- 1018- Toy – Original Design
- 1019-Toy – Made from kit
- 1020-Game-Must fit on 12” shelf and include directions
- 1021-Visual Aides-Create an item (book, puppet, etc.) to use when telling a child, a story. Include a summary of how it will be used.
- 1022-Storybook – Original design- must tell a story
- 1023-Original educational book or skit – not a story
- 1024-Stuffed animal or doll- original design
- 1025-Childcare kit- bag of toys, books etc. min. 10 items, identify items, age level, and use. List not acceptable.
- 1026-Basic First Aid Kit-include list of items & use.
- 1027-Babysitter’s Scrapbook- include pictures for specific age group

DIVISION P – BOOTHS

Themed booths shall use the following theme for 2022 “4-H Cares”
4- H/FFA PROMOTION

Division Rules & Regulations:

1. 4- H and FFA Members may exhibit in Sections I & II of this division. Only 4-H Members enter in this category.
2. Exhibitors and exhibits must comply with “General State Fair Rules & Regulations”, “General 4-H and FFA Rules & Regulations”, these “Division Rules & Regulations” and the applicable “Section Rules & Regulations”.
3. All exhibits must relate to and promote 4-H or FFA. Cartoon figures, such as SpongeBob, Bart Simpson, etc., cannot be used since they are copyrighted.
4. Booths and banners must primarily be the work of club or chapter members. Parents, leaders, and advisors may supervise and assist with the design but may not do a significant portion of the construction. Posters must be the work of the Exhibitor.
5. Exhibits previously entered in the Worcester County Fair are not allowed. Booth frames, etc. may be reused.

4- H and FFA CLUB/CHAPTER BOOTH CLASSES:

- There are two classes offered: A) Themed and B) Open.
- Themed booths shall use the following theme for 2022 “4-H Cares”
- Open booths may feature any theme promoting 4-H or FFA Size and Construction:
- Exterior booth dimensions must be: **36” W x 30” D x 16” H.**
- The sides must be in the shape of a right triangle using the following dimensions: 16” tall x 30” long/deep

ID CARD:

- Identification card must be typed not handwritten. Font size minimum 16pt.
- Card should be (business card size) 2”x3.5” in size and displayed horizontally.
- Securely attached to the bottom board, on the right front corner.
- The ID card must include the Club/Chapter Name and the county.
- Missing ID Cards will result in disqualification.

Booth Details:

- Nothing in the booth may be taller than the sides of the booth where the item is placed.
- No Electrical hookups will be provided.
- Structure **MUST** be constructed of durable materials that will look good for the duration of the fair.
- Booth items **MUST** be securely fastened to prevent damage, loss or to prevent items from shifting if moved. Booths are often relocated after they are dropped off, if items shift due to poor design they will be left where they fall.
- Failure to comply with these instructions may cause the booth to be disqualified and not receive a premium. Booths **MUST** Display:
 - Booth Title
 - Minimum of one **OFFICIAL** 4-H Clover or FFA crest must be displayed. Symbols must meet organization’s branding standards.
 - Suggestions: Use readable font choices and sizes, make sure to use proper clover and crest in readable formats, colors, and sizes. This is marketing/promotional display, make sure to highlight your organization. When displayed can we tell who is promoting this booth and what for? Be creative with placements of logos, text, graphics, and 3-dimensional items
