

DIVISION I – NATURAL RESOURCES COLLECTIONS

Section Rules & Regulations:

1. Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit per class. Due to limited exhibit space, collections are limited to one display case per class entered. Case dimensions may not exceed 25" x 30". Photos may be used to indicate the size/scope of collections too large to exhibit in their entirety.
2. Collections should include items collected from nature and identified as to common name, scientific name and state, region or country where collected. NOTE: Senior exhibitors must include additional information appropriate to the collection (e.g. where specimen is grown or found, native vs. non-native collection, dollar value of timber sales for various trees, etc.)
3. Collections will be judged on:
 - a. accuracy in naming and grouping by order
 - b. variety of species
 - c. neatness in labeling
 - d. neatness in display

- 516 - Rock Collection (min. 15 unpolished samples)
- 517 - Leaf Collection (min. 25 different samples from trees, shrubs, etc)

DIVISION J – NATURAL RESOURCES DISPLAYS

Section Rules & Regulations:

1. Exhibitors may only enter one exhibit per class.
2. Display may not be larger than 3'x4' by 3' tall.
3. May be science board or 3-dimensional.

DIVISION K – PHOTOGRAPHY

1. Each exhibitor will be limited to 1 entry in a class.
2. All photos should be mounted on mat board or illustration board using spray adhesive, heat seal, or other permanent mounting medium.

SECTION I – DIGITALLY MANIPULATED

Class

571 – Any digitally manipulated photo-altered using software must be entered under this class

3. Photos may be mounted horizontally or vertically. All photos must be a minimum of 5"x7" and not larger than 11"x14". Mat size should correspond to photo size as listed below:

<u>Photo Size</u>	<u>Mat Size</u>
5"x7"	8"x10"
8"x10"	11"x14"
11"x14"	16"x20"
Sequence	16"x20"

4. For classes 550 and 569, if two photos are used they should be 5"x7". If three or four photos are used, they should be 4"x6". If more photos are used, use a smaller, appropriate size to make a good exhibit.

5. No lettering permitted on front of mount or on picture. Name and address must be written on the back of the mount.

6. Classes will be judged in five age divisions: Junior 4-H, Intermediate 4-H, Senior 4-H, Open Youth and Open Adult.
